FULLERTON PLANNING COMMISSION
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS AVAILABLE FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT

Notice is hereby given that the City of Fullerton has completed an Initial Study of The Street Lights Fullerton Project (PRJ2020-00004) located at 215-229 East Orangethorpe Avenue and 1101 and 1111 South Lemon Street in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and CEQA Guidelines. On the basis of the Initial Study, City Staff has concluded that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and has therefore prepared a Draft Negative Declaration. The Initial Study is available for public review at the following locations for a period of 20-days from **Tuesday, September 7, 2021 through Monday, September 27, 2021**:

This matter is scheduled to be heard on **Wednesday, October 13, 2021 at 6:30 p.m.** by the Planning Commission in the Fullerton City Council Chamber, 303 West Commonwealth Avenue, Fullerton, CA 92832. PROJECT DESCRIPTION AND PLANNING COMMISSION ACTION ITEMS

The project proposes to construct a 329-unit, 5-story residential building (380,000 sq. ft.) wrapping a 567-space 6-story parking structure with up to 6,500 sq. ft. of retail on a 4.47-acre site. The Planning Commission action on this project will be a recommendation to the City Council who will make the final decision on whether to approve the following applications and adopt the Initial Study/Negative Declaration:

- **Major Site Plan (ZON-2020-0045)** for review of development concept, including site layout, architectural design, landscape design, and associated physical design features.
- **Minor Exception (ZON-2021-0114)** for a 5% reduction in certain parking stall dimensions.
- **Tentative Parcel Map (SUB-2020-0002 / TPM 2020-152)** to create one parcel under common ownership.
- **General Plan Land Use Amendment (LRP-2020-0011)** to change the existing Commercial land use designation to Urban Center Mixed-Use and to add C-3 as a consistent zoning designation with Urban Center Mixed-Use when used to implement dwelling units as part of a mixed-use development pursuant to 15.30.040.E.
- **Zoning Amendment (LRP-2020-0012)** to change the existing General Commercial (C-G) zoning classification to Central Business District Commercial (C-3).
