Addendum No. 2

Questions & Responses

1. Section 4.2, item 3.9 indicates all key personnel must be professionally licensed in CA as an Engineer, however Section 2 Minimum Qualifications indicates the proposed team must include a licensed geologist with hydrogeology expertise. In addition to a registered Engineer to provide engineering services under the scope of work, can other key personnel providing hydrogeology expertise and/or project management be licensed as a professional geologist/certified hydrogeologist, or are in fact all key personnel required to be registered Engineers?

A: Yes, other key personnel can provide hydrogeology expertise, so long as they are a licensed professional geologist/certified hydrogeologist. If the "Engineer of Record" who provides project oversight and is fully accountable for the validity and technical soundness of all material submitted to the City is licensed professional geologist/certified hydrogeologist, then the rest of the other staff need not be registered Engineers.
